SECTION XIV: FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Fire extinguishers are to be provided by the owner. Fire on board a boat is a very real and serious hazard. Fire extinguishers of the size and type recommended by the United States Coast Guard should be installed immediately.

Even more important than the number of extinguishers is the location of the units. They should be located near the areas where fires are most likely to occur (engine, fuel tank and galley). The extinguishers should be readily accessible in an emergency and not cut off from reach by the fire itself.

As a general guide we recommend locating fire extinguishers in the following areas:

- 1 in forward cabin
- 1 near galley
- 1 in cockpit locker accessible from
outside the cabin
